

Multifocal Contact Lens Study

WHAT IS THE GOAL OF THE STUDY?

This study will determine the level of comfort in presbyopic contact lens wearers of using digital screens for extended periods of time during the day.

WHO CAN PARTICIPATE?

Eligibility Criteria:

- Between 45 and 60 years of age and current contact lens wearers
- Using digital devices at least 8 hours per day for a minimum of 5 days per week, while wearing contact lenses at least 13 hours daily
- Contact lens prescription less than -5.00D, (inclusive), Spectacle prescription astigmatism ≤ 0.50D cyl
- Have healthy eyes with normal vision of 20/20
- No aversion to using Alcon ClearCare[®] solution

Further screening questions will be asked prior to scheduling an appointment

WHAT IS EXPECTED OF PARTICIPANTS?

- Participants will be assessed with a typical eye examination to verify eligibility
- Eligible participants will be expected to complete up to 4 visits over a 30-day period
- Each visit last up to 1-1.5 hours

WILL I BENEFIT FROM PARTICIPATING?

There is no direct benefit to participating in this study
